# Reminder: Student Biographical Data (SBD) Review

For accountability purposes, all districts are strongly encouraged to participate in the SBD process to ensure data is accurate (e.g., parent excusals, student withdrawals). These data cannot be updated afterward, including the request to reconsider process. The <u>SBD</u> review windows for PSAT/SAT and CMAS open soon. The windows are as follows: Colorado PSAT/SAT (May 15-22), Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS): Mathematics, ELA, CSLA, and Science and Colorado Alternate (CoAlt): Science (May 16-29), and Colorado Alternate (CoAlt): English Language Arts and Mathematics (Dynamic Learning Maps) (May 29-June 5). The <u>SBD Manual</u> includes a section beginning on page 20 that highlights important fields to review for accountability purposes.

Resources and supports will continue to be developed and released to support districts and school in implementing effective improvement planning.
