- •§tudents may have experienced ongoing reduced, disrupted and/or adjusted learning opportunities in school year 2021-2022
- •€onsider the pandemic's continued impact on learning opportunities for some students

- •htterpretation challenges increase as participation rates and/or representativeness** decrease
 •Some student groups may have tested at a higher rate than other groups
 •Data will not support all cross-state comparisons and historical uses when participation rates are low and/or representativeness** is limited
- •€ross-year comparisons should consider differences in participation rates and representativeness* across years
- *Representativeness: how well the demographics of the tested student population mirrored the demographics of the enrolled student population.
