	Requirements	

Holders of the CTE Behavioral Health authorization (grades 7-12) will be able to offer Behavioral Health Assistant I courses in the 511599 pathway that is aligned to the certificate. The ability of the authorization-holder to offer concurrent enrollment is limited to the following courses as long as the courses are connected to an approved secondary CTE program:

- PTE 1010 Introduction to Behavioral Health Care & Wellness
- BEH 1001 Mental Health Crisis & Intervention (MHCI): Preparedness and Empathy
- BEH 1030 Case management and Clinical Documentation
- BEH 2030 Applied Therapeutic Communication Skills

All applicants must meet content knowledge and occupational experience as outlined in one (1) of the ways identified A, B, C or D (below):

- A. Associate's or higher degree in a healthcare or behavioral health field <u>and</u> 4000 hours of verified occupational/industry experience or teaching behavioral health content within the past five (5) years.
- B. Associate's or higher degree in a healthcare or behavioral health field <u>and</u> completion of the Behavioral Health Assistant II micro-credential (or closely comparable program) and the courses below with a grade of B or better.
- C. Valid EMT, AEMT or Paramedic certification <u>and</u> 4000 hours of verified occupational/industry experience <u>and</u> completion of the Behavioral Health Assistant II micro-credential (or closely comparable program) and the courses below with a grade of B or better.
- D. Completion of the Behavioral Health Assistant II micro-credential (or closely comparable program) and the courses below with a grade of B or better <u>and</u> 4000 hours of verified occupational/industry experience or teaching behavioral health content within the past five (5) years.
