### Requirements

**U.S. service member applicants may meet content knowledge and experience requirements as follows:**

#### Content Knowledge/Experience Requirements

- Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy or Space Force members: three or more years' active duty
- Guard/Reserve members: 10 years' experience, or 5 years' experience with 12 months active-duty deployment
- Specialty (MOS), the time of service and an honorable discharge must be verified on a DD-214 member copy 4 (submitted in application)

**All other applicants must demonstrate requirements outlined in 1 and 2 below:**

#### 1. Content Knowledge:

- Hold a bachelor's or higher degree in a natural resource management, conservation biology or ecosystem science and sustainability field. **OR**
- Have completed 24 semester hours of related post-secondary coursework (as verified on an official transcript) to include a minimum of three (3) semester hours in five (5) areas listed in the table below.

#### 2. Experience:

- If you hold a bachelor's or higher degree: 2,000 hours of verified occupational (non-teaching) experience in the content area **OR**
- Three years' verified teaching experience in the content area (at least 51% or more of a teaching schedule dedicated to the content area)
