**Content Knowledge (Applicants must meet both A and B):**

- A.** Hold a valid Colorado secondary (7-12) teaching license with an endorsement in Theater Arts, English Language Arts or Speech.

**AND**

- B.** Have completed coursework in the content areas listed below (offered through the Colorado Community College System State CTE Office).

In order to move from an initial (three-year) to a professional (five-year) CTE authorization, you will need to complete a 40-hour (minimum) intern/externship in a field related to this content area.
