- must demonstrate content competency in **one** of the following ways:
- A. A bachelor's or higher degree from a regionally accredited college/university AND
- □ a passing score on the PRAXIS #5024 / 160 or
- □ an approved <u>Multiple Measures of Content Knowledge Competencies</u> submission

OR

- B. Hold a valid Colorado teacher license with an early childhood education (ages 0-8) endorsement.
- 2. To complete a Colorado alternative program/early childhood special education and to qualify to advance to an initial teacher license (or add an ECSE endorsement to a valid Colorado teacher license), all individuals must:
 - A. achieve a passing score on the following exams:
 - □ PRAXIS #5692 / 159 and
 - PRAXIS #5205 / 159

OR

B. demonstrate content competency of the teaching reading and early childhood special education standards via an approved <u>Multiple Measures of Content Knowledge Competencies</u> submission.
