Reading Street provides unique support through direct and explicit instruction; step-by-step instructional plan; an assessment plan to support high stakes testing and to ensure adequate yearly progress; customized instruction by strand; and differentiated instructional plans for struggling readers, advanced readers, and English Language Learners. Reading Street follows the three-tier RTI model of instruction through continuous progress monitoring and utilizing daily differentiated lesson plans. Reading Street is organized to promote language acquisition and concept development with reading selections that build students' reading skills and support content-area standards. Daily, weekly and unit writing tasks integrate the reading and writing process leading students to success on performance based writing assessments as required by the standards.
