## Instructions for pulling reports in COOL

Districts can now view a report of the educators in their school districts who have submitted evidence showing they meet the READ Act training requirement. This report is available to anyone who has already been approved for eLicensing Verification Access (EVA). CDE also has given access to every district superintendent and BOCES executive director.

If your school district's HR office has not been approved for access, they can do so by completing a form and applying via COOL.
