Requirements			
U.S. Service Member Applicants may r	neet content knowledge and experience requirements as follows:		

- U.S. Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy or Space Force members: three or more years' active duty
- Guard/Reserves: 10 years' experience, or five years' experience with 12 months active-duty deployment
- Military Occupational Specialty (MOS), time of service and an honorable discharge verified on a DD-214 member copy 4

All other applicants must meet all requirements outlined in 1 and 2 below:

1. Content Knowledge:

- a. 15 semester hours* of coursework from an accredited college/university in the selected Career Cluster (below) OR
- b. An industry-recognized credential to the selected Career Cluster, as identified on the <u>Colorado Development Incentive Program</u> <u>list</u> for the current fiscal year **OR**
- c. A valid state or national occupational license for the selected Career Cluster

2. Experience:

Credit for student teaching (up to 800 hours) in the content area may be applied to either occupational or teaching experience:

- a. 1,000 hours of verified occupational (non-teaching) experience in the selected Career Cluster **OR**
- b. Three (3) years' verified CTE-instructional experience in a related content area (full-time is defined as 51% or more of a teaching schedule dedicated to the content area)
