- School age children 6-12 and their parent/caregiver meet on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays 4-5 p.m. at the Children's Hospital Colorado Anschutz Campus

The patient group helps:

- Build self-esteem
- Develop social skills
- Have fun with others they feel comfortable being around
- Share feelings in a non-threatening environment
- Develop friendships

The parent group helps with:

- The ability to educate others on brain injuries
- How to balance the child's needs with other family priorities
- How to support educational and developmental growth
- Help extended family understand the child's needs
- How brain injury can "intensify previous personality characteristics"
- · Long-term plans and legal issues
- Sorting out the role of various professionals
- School options
- Connecting with other parents who share the ups and downs after brain injury
- · Connecting with others who understand how you feel and relate to what you are going through
