Bullying and Cyberbullying Offending Among US Youth: The Influence of Six Parenting Dimensions

- Positive parenting (warmth, structure, autonomy/support) linked to lower bullying and cyberbullying perpetration
- Negative parenting (rejection, chaos, coercion) linked to higher levels of bullying and cyberbullying perpetration
- Parental influence is stronger on cyberbullying compared to traditional bullying
