# Career Success Pilot Program 2016-17

# Program Overview

- General Assembly annually appropriates at least \$1M through August 31, 2019
- Districts/Charter Schools = up to \$1,000 per qualified credential (**Actual = \$553.40**)
- Funding Tiers:
  - Tier 1 - industry-recognized certificate
  - Tier 2 - internship, residency or construction industry pre-apprenticeship or apprenticeship program
  - Tier 3 - having received a minimum score of 3 on the end-of-course examination in AP Computer Science A or AP Computer Science Principles courses

# Participation

- 27 school districts
- 3,106 total qualifying credentials/courses reported
- 1,807 certificates funded
- 1,299 credentials/courses not funded
