ASD Educational Identification- ~~IN PERSON~~

Overview

The training is designed to support districts in understanding how to identify students suspected of having Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), using evaluation tools to assess the triad of characteristics of ASD. Participants will learn how to build a body of evidence to support the identification of ASD (determining eligibility) in an educational setting (without using the ADOS).

Details:

- Confirmation emails will be sent one week prior to the training.
- Registration is limited and will close two weeks prior to the start date.
- Who should attend: certified school professionals involved in assessment for the educational identification of ASD, including:
 - school psychologists, school social workers, speech/ language pathologists, special education teachers, occupational therapists, district administrators, certified team members who are part of the evaluation team.

Meals

A working lunch will NOT be provided at the training. Time will be given for participants to leave. Please plan accordingly.

Cost

The Exceptional Student Services Unit of the Colorado Department of Education provides the funding for the presenters. Venue space is provided by the hosting school district/AU or CDE. No reimbursement is provided to participants.

CDE hours and a certificate

Those who attend the full 12-hour requirement will receive CDE hours in the form of a certificate of attendance; partial credit will not be given. Both in-person days are required.
