Local School Wellness Policy Final Rule

- Published in the Federal Register on July 21, 2016
- During School Year 2016-2017, LEAs must begin developing a revised local school wellness policy.
- LEAs must fully comply with the requirements of the final rule by June 30, 2017.



LWP Final Rule - Updates

- Stakeholders* must be permitted to participate in the development, implementation, review, and update of the local wellness policy.
- Identify one or more LEA and/or school official(s) that will ensure each school complies with the policy.
- Inform and updating the public about the content and implementation of the local wellness policy.

^{*}Stakeholders = parents, students, representatives of the school food authority, teachers of physical education, school health professionals, the school board, school administrators, and the general public



LWP Final Rule - Updates

The wellness policy must include:

- Goals for nutrition promotion and education, physical activity, and other school-based activities that promote student wellness.
- Nutrition guidelines for all foods/beverages sold on the school campus during the school day.
- Policies for foods/beverages available on the school campus during the school day.
- Policies for food and beverage marketing.
- Description of public involvement, public updates, policy leadership, and evaluation plan.

LWP Final Rule - Updates

Evaluation

- All LEAs must assess their wellness policy at least once every three years on -
 - The extent to which schools are in compliance with the district policy,
 - The extent to which the local wellness policy compares to model local school wellness policies and
 - The progress made in attaining the goals of the local wellness policy.
- LEAs must make this assessment available to the public.



Smart Snacks in School Final Rule

- Published in Federal Register on July 29, 2016.
- Food and nutrition standards for all foods sold in schools, other than food sold under the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.



SSIS Final Rule - Updates

- Grain-only item is now considered an entrée for breakfast only
- Added definition for Paired Exempt Foods*:
 - Peanut butter and celery
 - Celery with peanut butter and unsweetened raisins
 - Reduced fat cheese and apples
 - Peanut butter and apples

*All retain total fat and saturated fat exemptions and may be served as long as the calorie and sodium limits are met.

SSIS Final Rule - Updates

- Eggs with no added fat are now exempt from total fat and saturated fat nutrient standards
- Low sodium and no-salt added canned vegetables with no added fat or ingredients except water or that contain a small amount of sugar for processing purposes exempt from nutrient standards
- Total fat nutrient standard remains an interim final rule



Administrative Review Final Rule

- Published in Federal Register on July 29, 2016
- Transparency requirement
 - All Administrative Review results for SY 2016-17 and beyond will be posted on CDE OSN website
 - We encourage SFAs to post the results, but at a minimum, provide the results upon request



Colorado Healthy Beverages Policy

 On September 14th, the CO State Board of Education voted in favor of the proposed changes to align federal and state rules.

Results

- Decreased regulatory burden on districts.
- Districts can include stricter beverage rules in their Local School Wellness Policies.

Next Steps

- Legal review by the Office of the Attorney General.
- OSN will post an update when the rules are finalized.
